

Cross Country Running at Bushy Park Wantirna South

1. THE COURSES

Permanent courses of varying lengths can be made up for the use of groups at Bushy Park in the Dandenong Valley Metropolitan Park. Running is all on grass, with the option to include obstacles if required. Organisers can devise their own courses by combining the various sections shown on the map.

2. MARKING AND ROUTE FINDING

A set of 'witches hats' is available to mark routes as required. Organisers are advised to familiarise themselves with the course well in advance of the event to select the course and to check conditions. Much of the area is low lying, wet in winter and will flood if the Creek rises after heavy rain.

3. OBSTACLES

A horse cross-country course is included in this area and a selection of jumps could be included as obstacles if this is desired.

4. CONDITIONS

Good supervision is essential to maintain the standards of the area. Groups must also be prepared to deal with accidents i.e. a car, first aid kit and medical care must be provided. The nearest public hospital is Dandenong and District, phone 791-6000.

5. CERTIFICATE

A master copy is provided which is suitable for duplicating and issuing to each participant upon completion of the course.

6. ACCESS AND FACILITIES

Access is off High Street Road via Bushy Park Road to Homestead Road, (see Melways 72 A1). Parking is available for up to 10 buses. Toilets, assembly area and a small shelter are on site. A barbecue can be provided by arrangement with the Ranger.

7. BOOKINGS

Bookings are essential and should be made through the Park Office in Jells Park in person or by calling 561-4776 during office hours. Further arrangements will then be made with the Ranger according to the needs of the group.

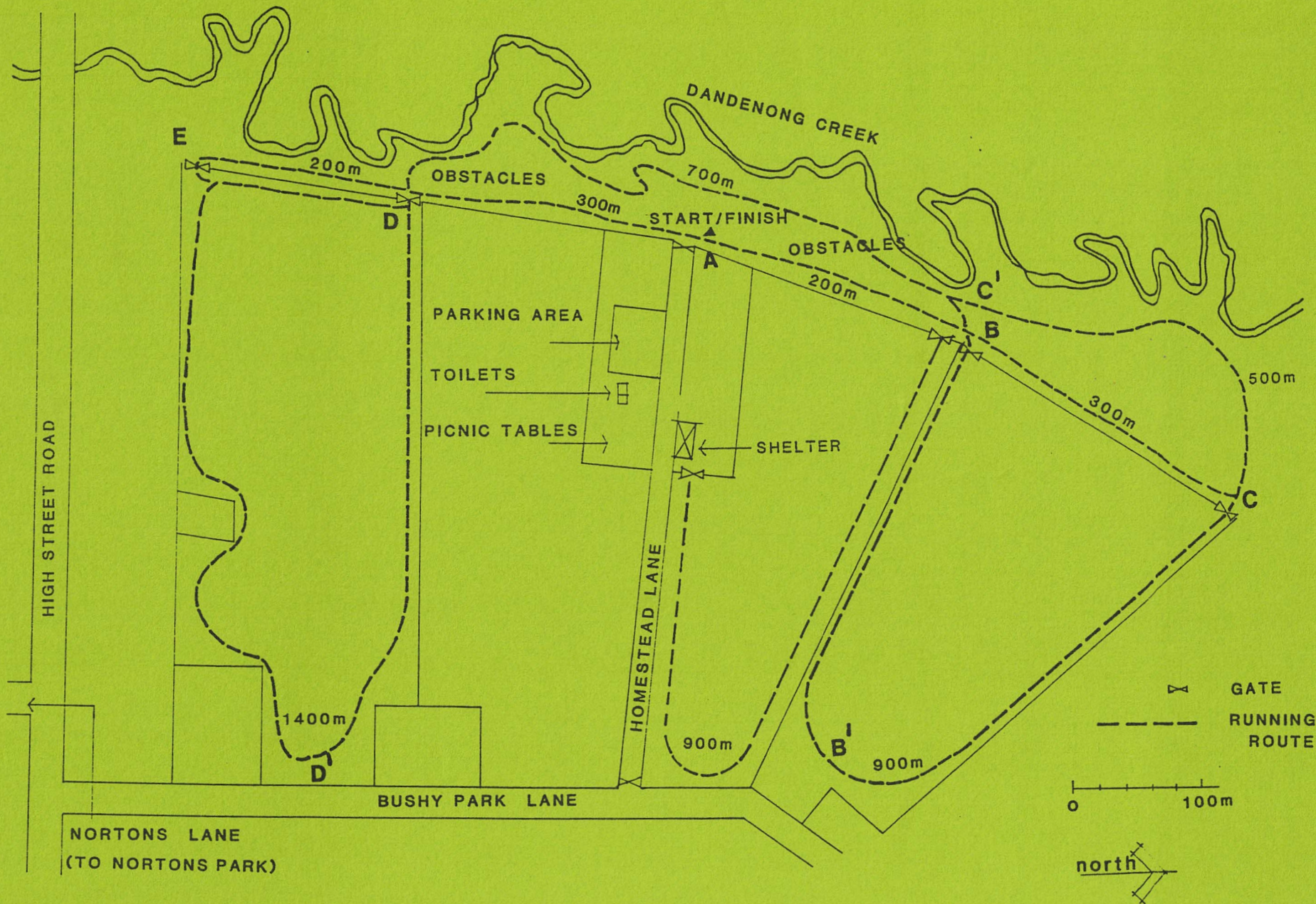
